**A Report on**  
**Awareness Programme on Neurological Diseases by Bindu Menon**

Neurological disabilities include a wide range of disorders, such as epilepsy, learning disabilities, neuro muscular disorders, autism, ADD epilepsy, brain tumors and cerebral palsy, just to name a few.

Globally, each year 53% of all strokes occur in women and women account for just over half (56%) of all persons who have experienced a stroke. Biological sex and sociocultural gender contribute to differences in stroke risk factors, assessment, treatment, and outcomes. In addition, in many socio-cultural contexts, including India, women have a key caregiver role within the family for elderly and disabled family members. To understand stress of caregivers of stroke survivors, three quarters of caregivers were females, especially spouses. Women play an important role in the Indian household and can be a support system in their homes to prevent risk factors, identify stroke and take immediate action against stroke.
