MINUTES OF THE MEETING:

The Governing Body held on 19-01-2014 (Sunday) at 11.00 AM in the conference hall, Main Block, Audisankara College of Engineering & Technology, Gudur, SPSR Nellore Dt., A.P.

- Welcome by Member-Secretary

Dr.A.V.S.Prasad member-secretary at the outset extended a cordial warm welcome to all the members of the Governing Body of Audisankara College of Engineering & Technology, Gudur.

- The Secretary & Correspondent Dr.V.Penchalaiah addressed the members of the Governing Body. In his address he requested the members to accord approval

and confirmation of the minutes of the previous GB meeting and in the absence of any discussion, sought for proceeding with the agenda further.

Item No: 1

Confirmation of the minutes of the earlier meeting held on 7th July 2013. Minutes of the previous meeting were circulated along with the agenda papers among the GB members. No comments were received and hence the minutes of the previous meeting were deemed to have been confirmed.

2. Principal's Report

2.1 Academic performance of students

I - B.Tech students of ASCET stood 1st among all JNTUA-Anantapur affiliated engineering colleges by securing highest pass percentage in I-B.Tech results of 2012-13 with overall pass percentage 77.14%. 48 I-B.Tech students got > 90%, 161 students 80% and 110 students 70% above.

Ms.CH.Yasaswini of I-B.Tech (ECE) topped the university results in JNTUA-Anantapur securing 95.60% in a.y. 2012-13.

Students from different branches were being placed in different organizations that conducted ON- and OFF-campus interviews. Many more such activities to be conducted are also being planned.

In view of the proposed new courses / additional intake proper steps to be taken to provide the required physical facilities such as building space etc., are in the pipeline.


Resolution No: 14/GBM-18/11/1
