MINUTES OF THE 20th GB MEETING:

The 20th GB Meeting of ASCET was held on 28.06.2015 (Sunday) at 11:00AM in the Chairman Board room main building of ASCET Gudur, SPSR Nellore District, AP.

Dr.V.KrishnaKumar, Principal, member-secretary extended a hearty welcome to the honorable Governing Body (GB) members of ASCET.

Dr. V.Penchalaiah , Secretary and Correspondent while welcoming the honorable GB members , requested the members to confirm the minutes of the 19th GB meeting and in the absence of any queries and discussion requested the members to proceed further to deliberate the agenda of the present meeting.

Item no. 1

Confirmation of the minutes of the last meeting i.e., 19th GB meeting held on 02.11.2014, which were circulated already in advance among the honorable members along with the agenda papers of the current meeting. 2. Principal Report

2.1 Academic performance of students

The academic performance of students of ASCET of IV B.Tech I Sem students (2015) with syllabi of JNTUA, the affiliated University is found very satisfactory and the Result analysis shows that the overall pass percentage is really encouraging. Academic performance of II and III B.Tech I semester students of ASCET (autonomous) is also very much encouraging.

5.1 Establishment of New labs and procuring equipment.

Two PG courses viz. The GB permitted the Principal to follow the established procedures laid down by university/Government in admissions into UG and PG courses offered for A.Y 2015 -16.

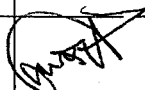
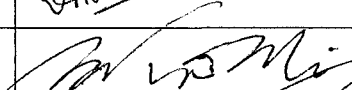
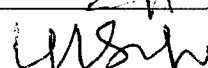

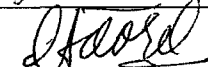
