The Chairman of the body welcomed all the members and gave an introductory message and advised the Director ASCET to start the proceedings.

Dr.V.Penchalaiah, Founding Chairman of Audisankara Group of Institutions, welcomed the honorable GB members and requested the members to confirm the minutes of 28th GB meeting held earlier and requested the members to proceed further to deliberate the agenda of the present meeting.

Item no.1: Confirmation of minutes of the 28th GB Meeting held on 25-09-2021 (Saturday) which were circulated to the honorable members along with the agenda papers of the current meeting in advance.
